#### Description

Example:

```
Print At(13,)+"Fail"
```

This fails at the 2nd parenthesis, with a syntax error, and at the end of the line with a type mismatch.

```
main.aoz:3:13: error: syntax error  
main.aoz:3:20: error: type mismatch
```
