## Description

It doesn't matter which disc archive it's from. I've tried importing code from:

AMOSPro\_Examples
AMOSPro\_Accessories
AMOSPro\_Tutorial
AMOSPro\_Productivity1
AMOSPro\_Productivity2

All produce the same " Problem during importation... " error. (See attachment.)

An empty folder structure for the imported application is created, then it crashes with the attached error.

For Example, for AMOSPro\_Examples/Help\_1.AMOS, I get the following folder structure:

AMAL\_1
resources
filesystem
application

...and then the import fails.

@Dave B tried this in the PC version - which does work, so apparently, this is specific to the Mac version.
