<b>Description</b>			
In version 1.0.0 (B8), the error messages are working <i>better</i> . Although the error <i>line</i> is reported properly, the <i>column</i> number in the line is always returning 1. For example, the following code should produce an error at column 66:			
<pre>E\$=" the Heavens and the earth!" Print "This is a test."; : Print "In the beginning", "god created"E\$ ' This should return an error at column 66 ' It's at that point we see that a comma or semicolon is missing.^ '  66 End</pre>			
...since it's at that point we know that a semicolon or comma has been omitted. Instead, the error is reported at byte 1. (In fact, ALL errors are reported at byte 1.):
